The Quality Assurance Plan (QAP) covers all CADA work processes related to fuel reception, quality testing, logistics, and delivery coordination performed by CADA Fuels Trading Division. The fuel delivered under this contract conformed to all national environmental requirements applicable to the geographic location of the receiving point.

CADA and Chevron executed a contract that ensures the supply of jet fuels from their Pascagoula Refinery to the DLA-designated receiving terminals. The DLA contract scope included the annual bulk fuel procurement for the Inland East Gulf Coast/Offshore (IEG) Purchase Programs. The fuel supplied covered various bases in the (IEGC) region of the United States, along Louisiana, Alabama, Mississippi, and Georgia. The delivery method via pipeline batch lifts serviced by Kinder Morgan Products (Plantation) Pipeline.
